

PICNIC POLICY

Palisades Interstate Park in New Jersey

THE PALISADES INTERSTATE PARK COMMISSION has provided the public with spaces and amenities for gatherings for over a century.

In the New Jersey Section of the Interstate Park, many of these spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis with the exceptions of **Carpenter's Grove, Alpine Grove** and the **Alpine Pavilion**.

409.1(l) Groups are limited to 25 people and must not use more than 5 tables and 1 grill. Individuals or groups must not reserve tables, parking spaces, grills or other amenities for group members that are not present in the Park.

408.1(g) A parking fee is collected and must be paid when an attendant is on duty. The fee ticket will not guarantee re-entry if the area is full and may not be used to reserve parking spaces.

409.1(12) Signs, balloons, banners and decorations of any kind must not be affixed to tables, trees, stones or park structures or staked into the ground.

410.1(n)(1) Alcohol is prohibited.

410.1 Games and athletic activities may be restricted to designated areas.

410.1(c) Garbage and recycling must be placed in proper receptacles.

408.1(f)(8) Music must not disturb the public.

412.2(a) Trucks, trailers and motorhomes are prohibited.

412.3(a)&(f) Buses and vans carrying over 15 passengers are allowed by permit only.

Personal grills are allowed but must not be placed on tabletops. 10'x10' shade tents, folding chairs, and folding tables are also permitted.
